In partnership with Blue Line Transfer Inc. and South San Francisco Scavenger Co., ZWE designed and developed the Blue Line Biogenic CNG Facility- a project essential in addressing numerous AB 32 requirements in California. The SMARTFERM dry AD system transforms 11,200 tons of food and green waste per year into biogenic compressed natural gas (bio CNG) and digestate that is processed into organic-certified compost. It is estimated that each collection vehicle will collect enough organic waste during just one route to fuel it for an entire day, creating a true closed loop system.
